COUNTY OF RANDOLPH

This being October 24, 2022, therefore, it is a regular meeting. A quorum was duly established with the following present: Chairman Derek Farr and Commissioners Pamela Johnson, Chris Brown, Lorenzo Foster and Larry Roberts.

Commissioner Johnson made a motion to amend the agenda to discuss the November 24 workshop falling on the Thanksgiving holiday and to discuss the December 22 workshop as well. Commissioner Brown seconded the motion. All member present and voting "aye," Chairman Farr declared the motion carried.

Commissioner Roberts made a motion to adopt the agenda as amended. Commissioner Brown second the motion. All members present and voting "aye," Chairman Farr declared the motion carried.

Commissioner Foster made a motion to approve the consent agenda as presented. Commissioner Johnson seconded the motion. All member present and voting "aye," Chairman Farr declared the motion carried.

Commissioner Johnson made a motion to adopt Resolution No. 2022-10B in honor of Southern Union State Community College's 100th year of educating. Commissioner Foster seconded the motion. All members present and voting "aye," Chairman Farr declared the motion carried. Randolph County Commission presented the resolution to Southern Union State Community College President Todd Shackett at the meeting. (Res. No. 2022-10B attached.)

Commissioner Roberts made a motion that the Chairman of the County Commission and a representative of the Volunteer Fire Association and Rescue Squad begin the process of surveying seven acres of land on the southern portion of the current jail site. His motion included the stipulation to be added to any conveyance of the property that if this property conveyed to the Volunteer Fire Association and Rescue Squad ever ceases to be used as a fire training facility and/or rescue squad site that the land be returned to the County Commission when both of those entities cease use or occupancy of the property. Roberts further moved that the Chairman authorize the County Attorney to draft the deed conveying the property to include this stipulation as soon as the survey has been done. Commissioner Foster seconded the motion. All members present and voting "aye," Chairman Farr declared the motion carried.

Commissioner Foster made a motion to adopt Resolution No. 2022-10C at the request of the ACCA. The resolution urges voters to vote "yes" on Amendment No. 2 and Amendment No. 7 on November 8, Election Day. Commissioner Johnson seconded the motion. All members present and voting "aye," Chairman Farr declared the motion carried. (Res. No. 2022-10C attached.)

Commissioner Roberts made a motion to approve a request from Randolph County E-911 to be allowed to pay for the county's drug screening services for their new employees at a rate of \$25. Commissioner Foster seconded the motion. All members present and voting "aye," Chairman Farr declared the motion carried.

Commissioner Johnson made a motion to adopt Resolution No. 2022-10D, urging all voters to vote "yes" on Amendment No. 1, "Aniah's Law," on November 8. Commissioner Foster seconded the motion. All

Commissioner Roberts made a motion to award the timber bridge decking bid (CCA) to Stringfellow of Birmingham. Commissioner Foster seconded the motion. All members present and voting "aye," Chairman Farr declared the motion carried.

Commissioner Roberts made a motion to award the corrugated metal pipe bid to Fallin Farms DBA Harvey Culvert of Cleveland, Ala. Commissioner Foster seconded the motion. All members present and voting "aye," Chairman Farr declared the motion carried.

Commissioner Roberts made a motion to reject the annual bids for granite, quartzite and limestone and rebid. Commissioner Brown seconded the motion. All members present and voting "aye," Chairman Farr declared the motion carried.

Commissioner Roberts made a motion to cancel the November 24, November 28, December 22 and December 26 meetings. Chairman Pro Tem Johnson seconded the motion. All members present and voting "aye," Chairman Farr declared the motion carried.

Commissioner Roberts made a motion to adjourn the commission meeting. Commissioner Foster seconded the motion. All members present and voting "aye," Chairman Farr declared the motion carried and the meeting adjourned.


