RE: Alabama's Revised Notary Act

**Date:** August 23, 2023

The Alabama legislature recently revised the Alabama's laws relating to the appointment of notaries public and the notary public office. *These changes become effective on September 1, 2023.* A summary of the changes can be found at **alpia.org**. All currently serving notaries are encouraged to familiarize themselves with these changes.

In order to apply for a new notary commission or renew a current notary in Randolph County, please see the new process below:

- 1. Go to <u>alpja.org</u> and complete the **Application for Notary Public Commission**, print and sign the application for submission to Probate Court. An application can also be provided by the Probate Office.
- 2. Complete the Notary Public Training Course. This training can ONLY be accessed at <u>alpja.org</u>. Print the certificate of completion.
- 3. Present the Application for Notary Public Commission, the training course certificate of completion and a Notary Bond in the amount of \$50,000 to the Probate Office.
- 4. Upon approval from the Probate Office, your Notary will be issued to you.
- 5. The cost will be \$77 and payable to the RANDOLPH COUNTY JUDGE OF PROBATE and is broken down as follows:
  - \$10 Application fee per AL Code 36-20-70(c)
  - \$25 Appointment/Commissioning by Probate Judge per AL Code 36-20-70(a)
  - \$10 Approval of Bond per AL Code 12-19-90(13)
  - \$15 State Recording fee per AL Code 12-19-90 (39)
  - \$3 Issuance of Notary Certificate per AL Code 12-19-90(19)
  - \$9 Local Recording Fee (\$3 per instrument application, training cert., & bond)
  - \$5 Local Transaction Fee
  - \$77.00
