Commissioner Roberts made a motion to approve the agenda. Commissioner Johnson seconded the motion. With all present voting "aye," Chairman Brown declared the motion carried.

Commissioner Roberts made a motion to approve the application submitted by Allen Food Marts Inc., located at 21143 Hwy. 431, Wedowee, for a 040-Retail Beer (on or off premises) and a 060-Retail Table Wine (on or off premises) alcoholic license. Chairman Brown and Commissioners Roberts and Johnson voted "aye," and Commissioners Farr and Foster abstained. Chairman Brown declared the motion carried.

Commissioner Roberts made a motion to renew the drug court contract with Patti McGuire. Commissioner Farr seconded the motion. With all present voting "aye," Chairman Brown declared the motion carried.

Commissioner Farr made a motion to table the renewal of the inmate medical contract with Southern Health Partners. Commissioner Roberts seconded the motion. With all present voting "aye," Chairman Brown declared the motion carried.
