Commissioner Johnson made a motion to approve the agreement with Guardian RFID in the amount of \$10,615.04 for RFID labels and wristbands at the jail. Commissioner Lunsford seconded the motion. All present and voting "aye," Chairman Pro Tem Farr declared the motion carried.

Commissioner Johnson made a motion to approve the consent agenda. Commissioner Lunsford seconded the motion. All present and voting "aye," Chairman Pro Tem Farr declared the motion carried.

This budget amendment will result in a net effect of \$0.00 to the General Fund and an \$11,000 use of savings from the Opioid Settlement Fund.

It would (1) account for the insurance claim revenue and expense to repair a 2018 Ram 2500 driven by Donnie Grant that was wrecked on 10/24/2024, (2) allow the jail to purchase a new Ford F150 Supercrew 4WD short bed pickup, and (3) allow the purchase of a RFID tagging system at the jail from Opioid Settlement Funds.
