This being Jan. 26, 2026, it is a regular meeting. A quorum was duly established with the following present: Chairman Pro Tem Pam Johnson and Commissioners Chris Lunsford, Larry Roberts and Lorenzo Foster. Commissioner Derek Farr was absent.

Commissioner Roberts made a motion to approve the agenda. Commissioner Lunsford seconded the motion. All present voting "aye," Chairman Pro Tem Johnson declared the motion carried.

Commissioner Lunsford made a motion to approve the consent agenda. Commissioner Foster seconded the motion. All present voting "aye," Chairman Pro Tem Johnson declared the motion carried.

Commissioner Foster made a motion to accept the \$93,854.01 proposal from Porter-Higgenbotham Engineering Inc. of Fayette for construction, engineering and inspection services on the declared FEMA project on County Road 7 and authorize the county engineer to execute the documents. Commissioner Lunsford seconded the motion. All present voting "aye," Chairman Pro Tem Johnson declared the motion carried.

Commissioner Foster made a motion to accept the \$4,900 proposal from Acai Construction Testing of Auburn for the soil testing on the annual Rebuild Alabama grant project on County Road 868 and authorize the county engineer to execute the documents. Commissioner Lunsford seconded the motion. All present voting "aye," Chairman Pro Tem Johnson declared the motion carried.

Commissioner Roberts made a motion to award the annual surface treatment bid to the lowest bidder, Charles E. Watts Inc. of Gadsden, and approve the insignificant variant from the invitation to bid requirements, specifically labeling the outside of the envelope with "Bid: Annual Surface Treatment Bid 2026" vs. "Bid Proposal for Randolph County Annual Surface Treatment Bid," which does not affect the quality of the product to be received. Commissioner Foster seconded the motion. All present voting "aye," Chairman Pro Tem Johnson declared the motion carried.

Commissioner Roberts made a motion to award the annual in-place plant mix bid to the lowest bidder, Gary Ingram Grading and Paving Inc. of Dadeville. Commissioner Lunsford seconded the motion. All present voting "aye," Chairman Pro Tem Johnson declared the motion carried.

Commissioner Roberts made a motion to renew the lease for the Probation and Parole office and authorize the county administrator to execute the documents. Commissioner Foster seconded the motion. All present voting "aye," Chairman Pro Tem Johnson declared the motion carried.

Commissioner Foster made a motion to allow Combined Public Communications to implement a cost recovery additive of \$0.02 per minute for regulated inmate telephone and video communication services, subject to the Federal Communications Commission rules and limitations and authorize the county administrator to execute the attestation and authorization documents. Commissioner Roberts seconded the motion. All present voting "aye," Chairman Pro Tem Johnson declared the motion carried.

At this point, Commission Chairman Derek Farr joined the meeting.

Commissioner Roberts made a motion to authorize the jail administrator to destroy old surplus uniforms and mattresses from the jail. Commissioner Lunsford seconded the motion. All present "aye," Chairman Pro Tem Johnson declared the motion carried.

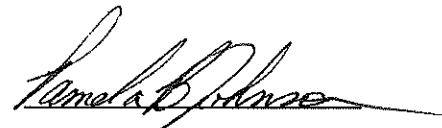

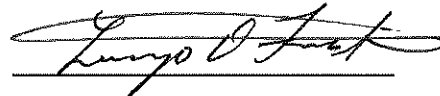
