





PROCLAMATION DECLARING THE MONTH OF MARCH 2026 AS "COLORECTAL CANCER AWARENESS MONTH"

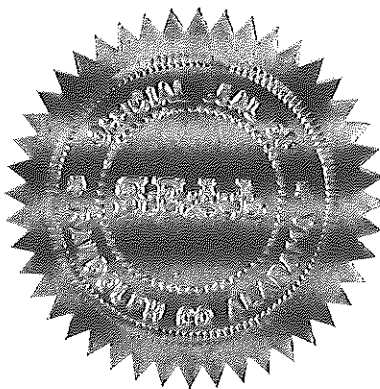
